About the training

The present course is aimed for Master's degree students studying in the area of Biochemistry, Nutrition, Food Science and Technology, Fisheries and Life sciences.

Travel, food, and accommodation

The candidates selected for training shall be reimbursed travel expenses (to and fro) as per their entitlement restricted up to sleeper class rail fare by the shortest route subject to submission of original tickets.

Participants will be provided with food and accommodation as per ICAR norms, and will be accommodation in the ICAR-CIFT Trainees Hostel on sharing basis.

Duration

The training is of 5 days duration and is scheduled from 16th to 20th December 2024. Outstation participants are required to reach ICAR-CIFT latest by evening of December 15th 2024. The participants are advised to plan their return journey evening onwards on December 20th, 2024.



Eligibility

This is a special capacity-building programme for the students belonging to the Scheduled Caste category.

Postgraduate students and final year Bachelor's degree students from the State AUs/CAU/Agriculture colleges in the disciplines of Biochemistry, Nutrition Food Science and Technology, Fisheries and Life sciences are eligible to apply.

A total of 15 candidates will be selected for the course. The selection of the candidates shall be made by a screening committee as per the guidelines of ICAR. The selected candidates will be intimated

regarding their selection accordingly.
