#### **ICAR-CIFT**

#### About the training

#### Eligibility

A total of 20 candidates shall be selected for the course. A screening committee shall make the selection of the candidates as per the guidelines of ICAR. The selected candidates shall be intimated regarding their selection for training on 21<sup>st</sup> January 2025. Students belonging to general and other categories, other than scheduled tribe category, need to pay the course fee (Rs. 10,000/- + GST), as well as all other expenses.

#### Procedure of participation

Eligible candidates may prepare as per the format given in the brochure. The participants may send the application form duly filled in and approved by the competent authority of the organization to the Course Director at the address given in the brochure by email (qamdiv@gmail.com).

#### Travel, Food & Accomodation

The candidates (belonging to scheduled tribe category) selected for participation in the training shall be reimbursed travel expenses (to and fro) as per their entitlement restricted up to sleeper class rail fare by the shortest route subject to submission of documentary evidence in terms of original tickets. Participants will be provided with food & accommodation as per ICAR norms at the expense of CIFT.
